ABOUT THIS TOUR:

Explore the most astounding Mesoamerican ancient city guided by an expert in history and art with a passion for archaeology and the past. Visit in situ murals, appreciate their architecture and learn about everyday life, rituals, and secrets.

What will be visited

Begin the visit by exploring the **Quetzalcoatl temple**, a wondrous plaza that served as a gathering place for the diverse groups that inhabited the city. **Climb its temple** and admire sacred art and sculpture that explains the foundational myths of the Mesoamerican cultures.



Continue the tour by wandering inside the **Tetitla Palace**, a habitational complex decorated with in situ murals of everyday life and religion, with moving touching, mysterious iconic paintings made with lush colors.



An elaborate yet succinct introduction made with diagrams and images of the key concepts of Mesoamerican culture will be delivered by your guide, alongside an explanation of their **everyday life** and their living spaces that will take place as we **walk through the rooms of the palace** and complex.

Wander around and admire two of the **largest pyramids in all the Americas**. Discover how these outstanding monuments were created, and dig deeper into their political, religious, and cosmological significance and recent scientific and historical findings.



Finish this walking tour visiting the **Tepantitla Palace**, a site hosting the most **impressive mural** of all Teotihuacan: the mural of Tlalocan. In Aztec mythology, Tlalocan was the marvelous underworld ruled by the water deity Tlaloc. In the painting, many small figurines play or dance around a hill formed by waterfalls and rivers in what is typically known as the **“Paradise of Tlaloc.”**
